IQAC organized Workshop on “Google Classroom as a Tool of Support of Blended Learning to Enhance Quality of Teaching, Learning and Evaluation”

Moodle is a traditional tool for supporting blended learning in higher education. Google Classroom is an alternative option to Moodle for open learning management systems. Google Classrooms is a very powerful tool of supporting blended training, incredibly easy to use and create an online educational environment. Google Classroom is an educational interactive tool that allows creating an informatively rich educational environment integrating the Google Docs text editor, Google Drive cloud storage, Gmail and other applications (YouTube, Google Sheets, Google Slides, Google Forms, etc.).

The advantages of using the specified interactive tool during the study of any disciplines are highlighted during this training. The organization of the learning process using Google Classroom ensures the unity of in-class and out-of-class learning; it is designed to realize

effective interaction of the subjects learning in real time; to monitor the quality of training and control the students' learning achievements in class as well as out of it, etc. Google Classroom would be open to anyone with a Google account. So every department can set up a Google classroom where anyone who wish, can join the class and take advantage of this remarkable tool that makes education, training, and even outreach possible.

Goal

To intensify, consecutive effective Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) planned in phased manner for the use of 'The Google Classroom as a Tool of Support of Blended Learning to Enhance Quality of Teaching, Learning and Evaluation'

Objectives

The objectives of the FDPs are to:

- Highlight the experience of supporting the blended training by using Google Classroom.
- Understand the real-time interaction of real-time learning subjects
- Increase the visual aids in learning
- Provide constant pedagogical support and ensure the integrity of both in-class and out-of-class work
- Develop critical thinking and enhance competencies in teaching, learning and evaluation
- Attract students to the familiar electronic environment with the use of ICT that facilitate the operational control of educational achievements.

Outcomes

Upon completion of this faculty training programme, faculty members will:

- Gain working knowledge on setting up their Google Classroom and learn the basic functions of Google Classroom homepage and its functionality.
- Navigate both student and teacher interface with the maximum comfort level.
- Create and save files in Google Drive to share with others.
- Create assignment programs and criteria.
- Understand all options for student submission of assignments.
- Grasp knowledge about other apps to assist with assignments and grading.
- Act as experts in Google Classroom and share experience and information with other faculty members.
- Gather knowledge and information on apps that can assist teachers in Google Classroom.

Faculty development programme on “OER, Content Development, MOOCS and MOODLE” on 13.12.18 in Audio Visual Room. 110 faculty members participated in it.

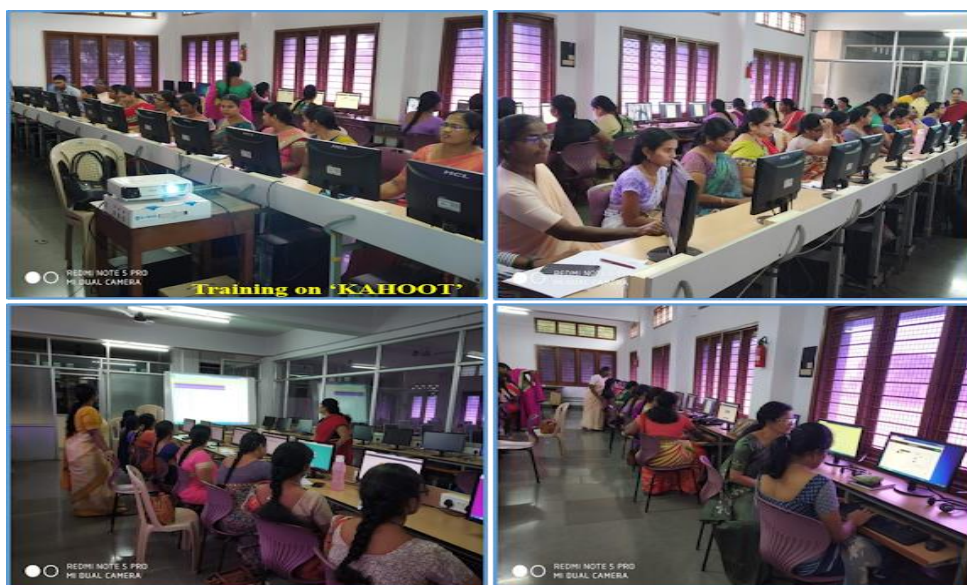

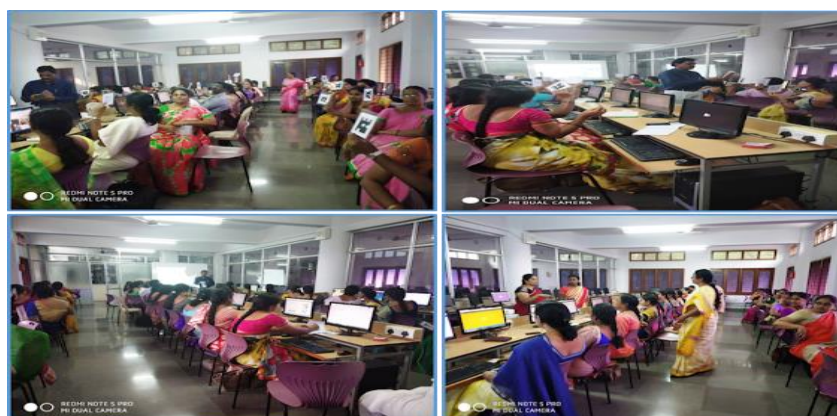

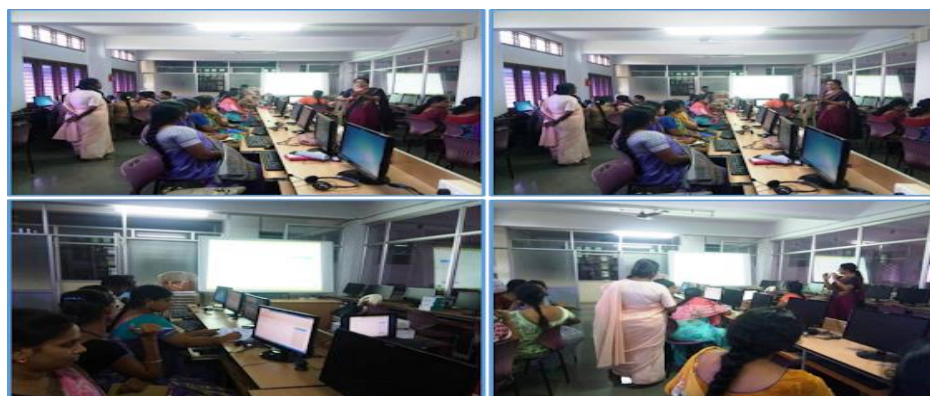

Observations of the Internal Audit Team:

1. Newly established departments need to maintain and update records.
2. Student progression register needs to be updated.
3. Student profiles are to be maintained by each course teacher.
4. Record of student field projects has to be maintained, especially by those departments having student projects for 100 marks.
5. Record of Analysis of Students: grouping of students into Slow, Moderate and Advanced learners and action taken needs to be maintained by each course teacher.
6. Result of the students, course-wise, has to be analysed each semester and an ATR recorded.

Recommendations:

1. E-content can be developed by each course teacher
2. Can publish more research articles
3. Department- related extension activities can be planned.
Suggested that department wise, at least one outreach activity related to community service per semester be taken place.
4. Guidance for career counselling and coaching for competitive examinations can be arranged on the campus for the benefit of students.
5. Faculty can apply for Minor / Major projects
6. Can have more MoUs / Collaborative activities.
