

#### Orientation on Incubation and Entrepreneurship, 16th March 2021

The Entrepreneurship Development Cell in association with IQAC organized an orientation for II UG and I MBA students on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2021in the auditorium from 2.00 pm to 4.00 pm.

The resource persons were Dr. Rajasekhar, Professor, Department of CSE, KL University, CIIE, Ms. Y. Jyotsna, Founder "IUThink", Mr. A. Gopi Raja, CEO FOPPLE Drone Tech Pvt. Ltd.

Prof. Rajasekhar addressed the students on the identification of opportunities and thinking creatively to solve the problems faced by the people in society. He also mentioned that finance is not at all an obstacle to starting an enterprise, as there are many governments and private funding agencies to support startups.

Ms. Jyotsna, highlighted that the objective of IUThink is to create a proper Startup Ecosystem to connect all the entrepreneurs. It also provides a platform for Rural, Student Entrepreneurs and Startups. They also provide entrepreneurial functionality support for existing incubations. She said that students must have the perseverance to become entrepreneurs and also focus on their goals until they achieve them. She also said that their organization is ready to mentor budding young entrepreneurs and transform them into successful entities.

Mr. A. Gopi Raja cited his own life as an example of how his father's struggle had driven him to innovate drones to spray pesticides in the farmland. As a student of B.Tech from KL University, he was into developing drone technology. The

incubation centre of KLU had supported him to become a successful entrepreneur. He inspired the students to take the best advantage of the available infrastructure in the college and become job givers instead of job seekers.

The resource person was Mr. Sree Krishna Seelam, a freelance trainer and founder of many startups.

The objective of organising this programme was to make students aware of the need to assess whether ideas generated are scalable or not and to identify the students who would be interested in joining a 10-month Entrepreneurship Development Programme that encompasses idea generation to the scalability of the ideas.

The expected outcome of the EDP was to instill thought processes among students and to brainstorm among themselves and develop the creative skills to come up with innovative ideas and start new ventures.

The resource person has told the students on how to brain storm among themselves and come out with a viable idea. He also said that many start-ups have emerged during Covid 19 pandemic, as it was taken as an opportunity rather than a problem.

The resource person was Ms Aparna, CEO, Aparna Jute, Vijayawada, an alumni and a successful entrepreneur. It was an interactive programme, during which the resource person shared her entrepreneurial experiences and students posed queries on difficulties in starting as well as managing a firm. The speaker was able to address the questions effectively and closed the session with the advice that while problems always have solutions, a successful entrepreneur needs to be able to take initiatives, be innovative and committed.
