# Report on National Level Webinar on "Publication of Academic Research in Peer-Reviewed Scholarly Journals", held on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

The PG Department of Business Administration in association IQAC has organised a one-day national webinar on "Publication of Academic Research in Peer-Reviewed Scholarly Journals", on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2020. The keynote speaker was Dr. K. Krishna Reddy, Registrar Krishna University Machilipatnam. The resource person for the webinar was Prof. V. Krishna Mohan, Registrar, Andhra University, Visakhapatnam. Dr. Sr. Jasintha Quadras was the chief patron for the webinar.

The programme began with a prayer song by Dr. Sr. Lavanya, Faculty, PG Department of Business Administration.

The objective of the webinar was to emphasize research for academicians and the importance of publishing articles in scholarly journals.


The programme started with the principal's welcome address, followed by the keynote speaker. The keynote speaker was introduced by Dr. K.Naga Sundari, Head, PG Department of Business Administration.

Dr. K. Krishna Reddy, the keynote speaker, addressed the importance of research for academicians. He also reiterated that the focus should be on the quality but not on the number of papers for publication. A research gap must be identified to produce original work rather than copying from different references. Research must enhance the academics of a faculty and add value to their profile.

Prof V. Krishna Mohan was introduced to the participants by Dr. Sr. Lavanya.

Prof. V. Krishna Mohan, spoke on research in higher education. He emphasized the role and responsibilities of a teacher. The first role is teaching, the second is research and the third one is consultancy, which adds value to the institution. While publishing research articles faculty must focus on value and quality rather than volumes. He also mentioned different factors to justify scientific validation for research work. To become more proficient in writing research articles, practice is the only mantra and to keep producing good papers for the benefit of society.

A guest lecture on 'Preparation of Research Project Proposals for Funding' was organized by the IQAC, Maris Stella College on 22.01.2021 for the faculty members with Ph.D. The two hour guest lecture was arranged to make the faculty equipped with the skills of writing proposals for research projects, endowments, seminars, conferences etc. to funding agencies like DST, FIST, ICSSR, UGC etc. for grants.



Welcome address by Dr. Sr. Jasintha Quadras – 12.01.2021

The resource person was Dr. Veera Brahmachari, HoD, Biotechnology, Krishna University, Machilipatnam. The resource person and participants were welcomed by the Principal, Dr. Sr. Jasintha Quadras followed by a brief introduction of the guest lecture by Dr. Jasintha Quadras.

Dr. Brahmachari gave details on how to write project proposals to various funding agencies for grants, the process, formats, budget, timelines and the measures to take in getting grants. Dr. Chari gave useful inputs on different funding agencies and explained to the participants how to make use of the available opportunities to get things done. The resource person stressed upon the importance of collaborative research and suggested that faculty may apply for guideship to promote research culture. Dr. Brahmachari also suggested that authenticated software for plagiarism check may be used by the institution
