



Outcomes


By the end of the workshop participants will be able to




Feedback from participants for day 1-03.09.2021

The second day started with a revision of topics which were discussed in the previous day. Next, sir had given practice on Regression and Correlation methods and also on applying sample tests to different kinds of data.




Testing of Hypothesis using SPSS by Dr. Ravanan, 04.09.2021


