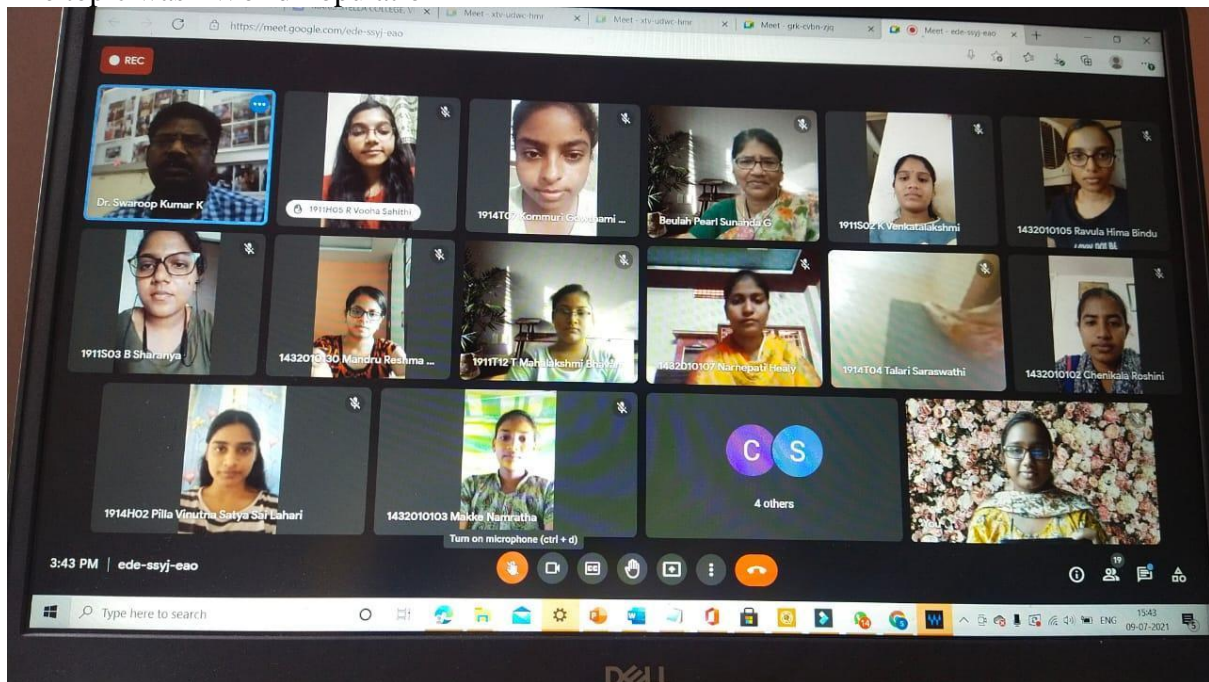
1. World Population Day 10.7.2021

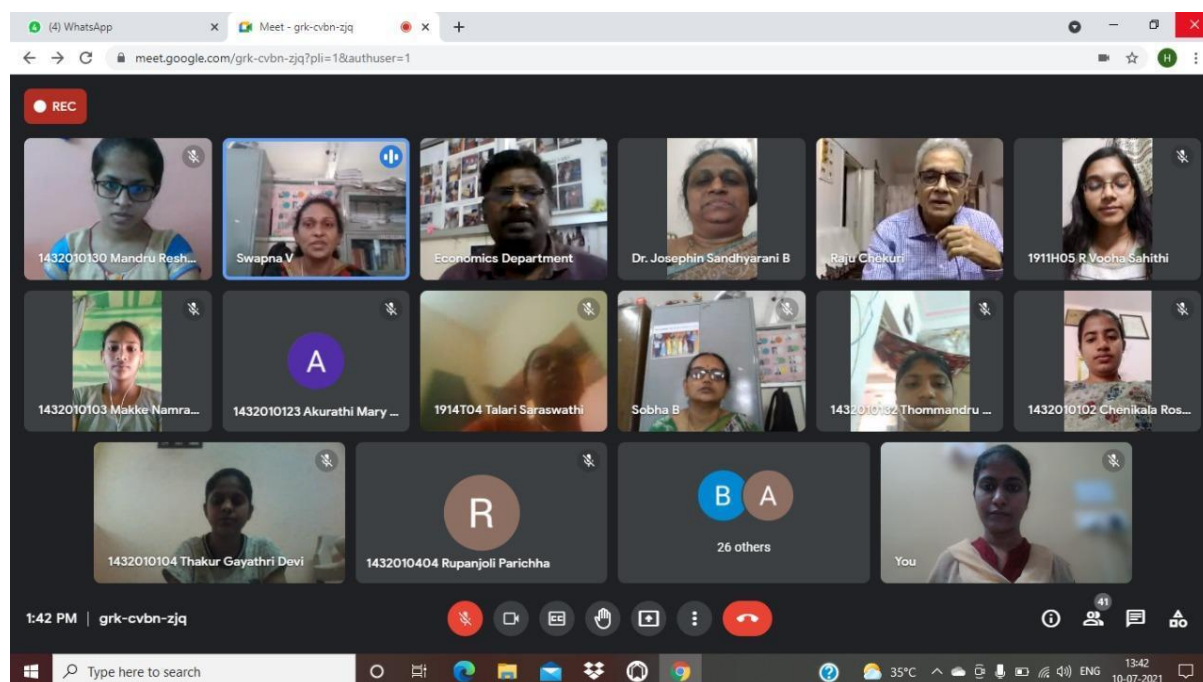
A total of 10 students have participated in Poster making competitions, 13 students have participated in Essay writing competitions.
