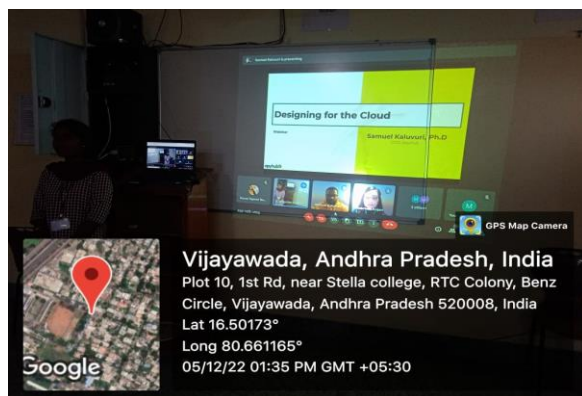

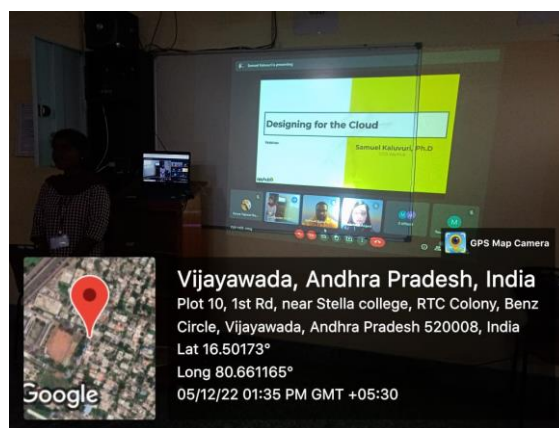
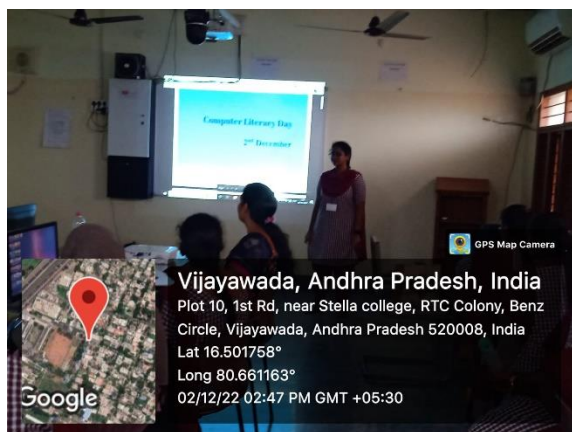
Students participating in the webinar on 05-12-2022
