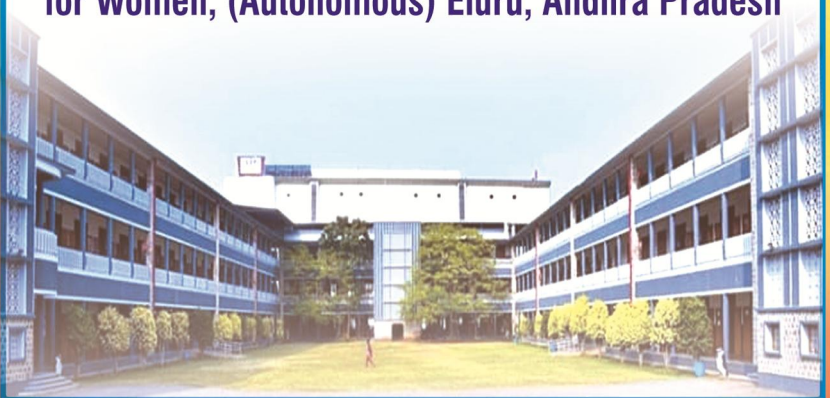

Authors are invited to present their original and unpublished articles on the following areas:

- Evolution of India's global diplomacy-relevant challenges and issues-Exploring India's colonial past, independence struggle, and its shift in diplomatic strategy from Non-Alignment to Multi-Alignment.

- Assessing India's cultural and soft power efforts and their impact on global perceptions.
- Examining India's role in international organizations and its impact on global governance.
- Analyzing India's defense policies and its role in regional and global security.
- India's Climate Change Diplomacy: Analyzing its stance and impact on global environmental diplomacy.
- India's Humanitarian Aid and Development: Evaluating its global contributions and role in international development.
- India's Diplomatic Initiatives: Analyzing its approach to global issues like terrorism, cybersecurity and nuclear proliferation.
- Diaspora Diplomacy: Examining the impact of the Indian diaspora on India's global relations and perception.

- An abstract not exceeding 500 words and full length paper of 1500-2000 words
- Abstract and full length paper must be in IEEE format
- Certificate will be issued to both the paper presenters and the participants
